

Adjustments to the Eurosystem publication of liquidity data

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MMCG call on 1 December 2020

ECB publication of liquidity data

- General purpose: ECB publishes liquidity data (e.g. autonomous factors, tender operations etc.) to provide information on central bank liquidity dynamics
- Past role: To provide a information relevant for bidding at ECB open market operations and for evaluating market dynamics
- Current role: Transparency to the market on liquidity developments

→ Changes were recently agreed to improve operational efficiency

ECB announced on 20 November:

- Suspension of the publication of the MRO benchmark amount;
- Reduction in the frequency of publication of the autonomous factor forecast to once a week and to align it with the release of other liquidity data at 11:30 CET on the MRO announcement day;
- New publication time of daily liquidity data at 11:30 CET.
- Applicable as from 14 December.
- Purpose: to increase operational efficiency and streamlining operational processes.

Suspension of publication of MRO benchmark amount

No publication of MRO benchmark as from 14 December. For example:

Reduced frequency of the autonomous factor forecasts

- Publication of average changed from AF forecast to once per week from twice per week.
- As from 14 Dec.: Publication usually on Mondays covering roughly the week ahead.
- Publication will be aligned with the release of other liquidity data at 11:30 CET and not anymore with MRO announcements and allotment publications.
